Uniform Policy

This Uniform Policy is supplemental to the Uniform Policy found in Section Ten (10) of the Waterbury Police Explorer By-Laws.

All explorers are expected to be in complete uniform at all sanctioned meetings and events, unless advised otherwise. Class “B” Uniform includes: post issued hi-viz shirt, post issued BDU pants, and black shoes. Class “A” Uniform includes: post issued blue uniform shirt with issued badge, post issued striped uniform pants and black shoes.

Only hats that should be used are post issued baseball caps or knit hats for Class “B” Uniform and post issued 8-Point Cap for Class “A” Uniform.

Special Divisions uniforms (i.e. Honor Guard, Bike, SWAT) should only be worn when advised to. Please see the appropriate Division Commander for more information regarding the specific uniform details.

In addition to the above mentioned uniform policy all explorers should carry a pocket notebook, two (2) pens, and wear a black belt at all times. Duty belts are acceptable with only approved equipment as prescribed in the Waterbury Police Explorer By-Laws.

Any explorer who receives the appropriate supervisor approval to attend a sanctioned meeting or event out of uniform will abide by the Waterbury Public School Dress Code and in addition will tuck in the collared shirt, creating a professional attire presence.

Seasonal Uniform (long sleeve vs. short sleeve) will be announced on social media and mass notification system.

Failure to abide by the uniform policy instated above will result in:

- First Offense- Verbal Warning
- Second Offense- PAR Documentation/ Two Month Probation
- Third Offense- Two Month Suspension
- Fourth Offense- Disciplinary Action Approved by Post Captain & Advisors—may include termination
